

World Structure of Futures and Forex Markets

FUTURE

- Futures contracts are agreements to buy or sell an asset at a
 predetermined price at a specified time in the future. They are
 commonly used for commodities like oil, gold, and agricultural
 products.
- Major exchanges include CME and NYMEX, which facilitate global trading of these contracts.
- Example: A gold futures contract allows a trader to hedge against fluctuations in gold prices, ensuring stability for both buyers and sellers.

FOREX

- Daily Trading Volume: \$7.5 trillion+, making it the largest and most liquid financial market globally.
- Global Accessibility: Operates 24/5, allowing participants from various time zones to trade continuously.
- Key Participants: Banks, institutions, hedge funds, and retail traders actively engage in currency trading, shaping the market dynamics.
- Economic Influence Example: Suppose a multinational corporation in Europe meet to purchase raw materials from the United States. It must convert its Euro earning to US Dollars through the Forex market, demonstrating its vital role in global trade facilitation.
- Impact of Forex Movements: Changes in currency exchange rates can significantly affect imports, exports, and even international investments, emphasizing the need to understand Forex trends.

Prop Firm

- Definition: Proprietary trading firms provide traders with capital to trade in various financial markets. Traders use the firm's funds instead of their own.
- Structure: Traders are evaluated based on their performance during a simulated or real trading evaluation phase. Successful traders receive funding and share a portion of their profits with the firm.
- Example: A trader passing a prop firm's evaluation program could gain access to \$50,000 in trading capital, with a profit split of 80% to the trader and 20% to the firm.
- Safety for Clients: Clients only need to invest towards the purchase of evaluation accounts on the prop firm's platform. This minimizes their financial risk compared to traditional trading, as they are not directly risking large sums of personal capital in the markets.

WHAT IS A PROP FIRM?

Brokerage Firm

- Definition: Brokerages act as intermediaries, providing traders access to financial markets for buying and selling assets.
- Services Offered: They offer platforms, market data, and tools to facilitate trades, and may charge commissions or spreads for their services.
- Examples: Forex brokers provide access to the currency market, while futures brokers specialize in commodities like oil, gold, and agricultural products.
- Risk to Clients Clients need to invest their own capital for trading and bear the risk of potential losses, which can vary based on market conditions and trading strategies used. Effective risk management is essential to minimize these potential losses.




